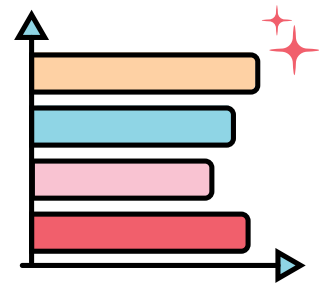

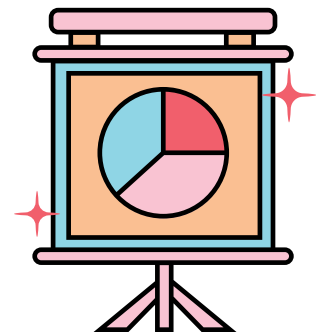

*This was a shift as compared to the 2021-2022 school year findings in which the top challenges were student health, familial challenges (social determinants of health), and environment. While student behavior, including loss of motivation and interest in school as well as bullying, was among the top 3 concerns, student health and familial challenges remained key drivers of missed school.

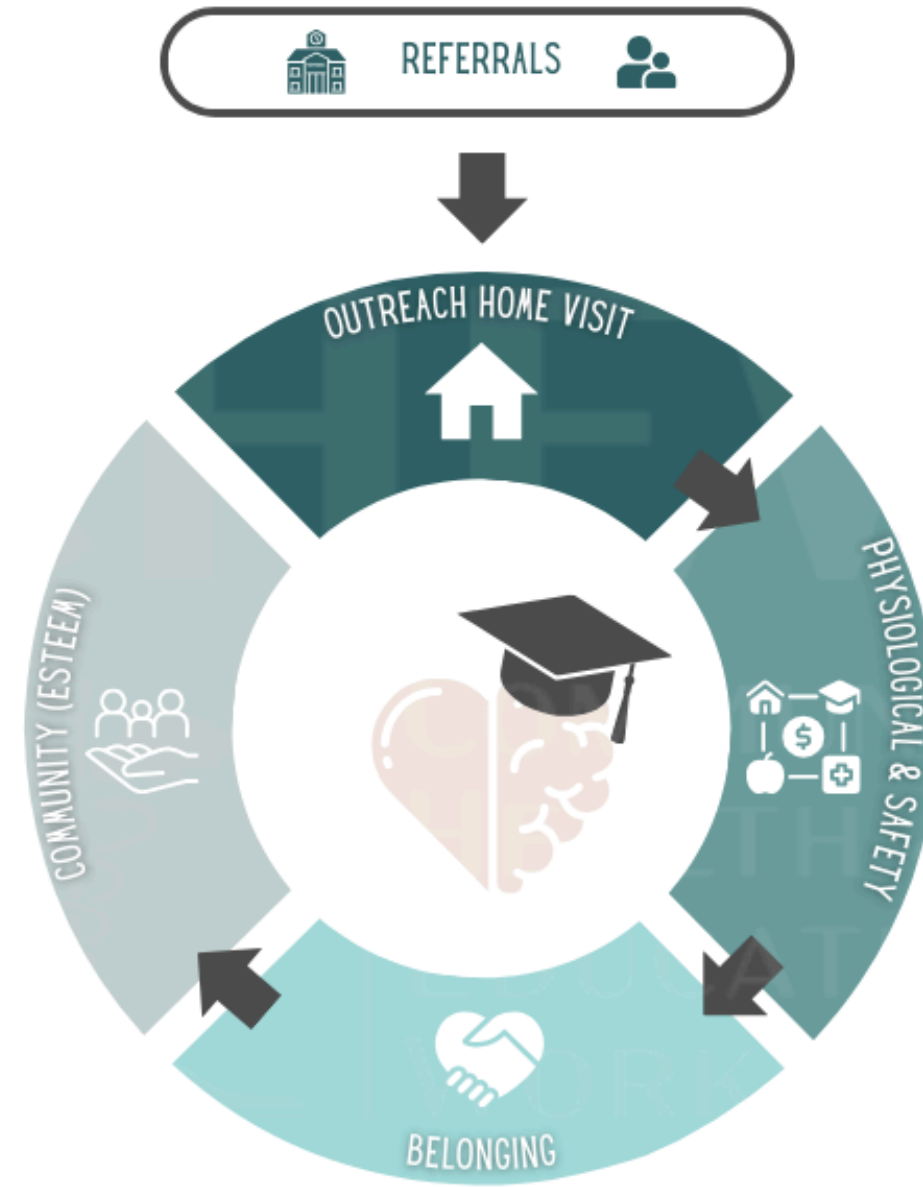

CHEW Integration Model



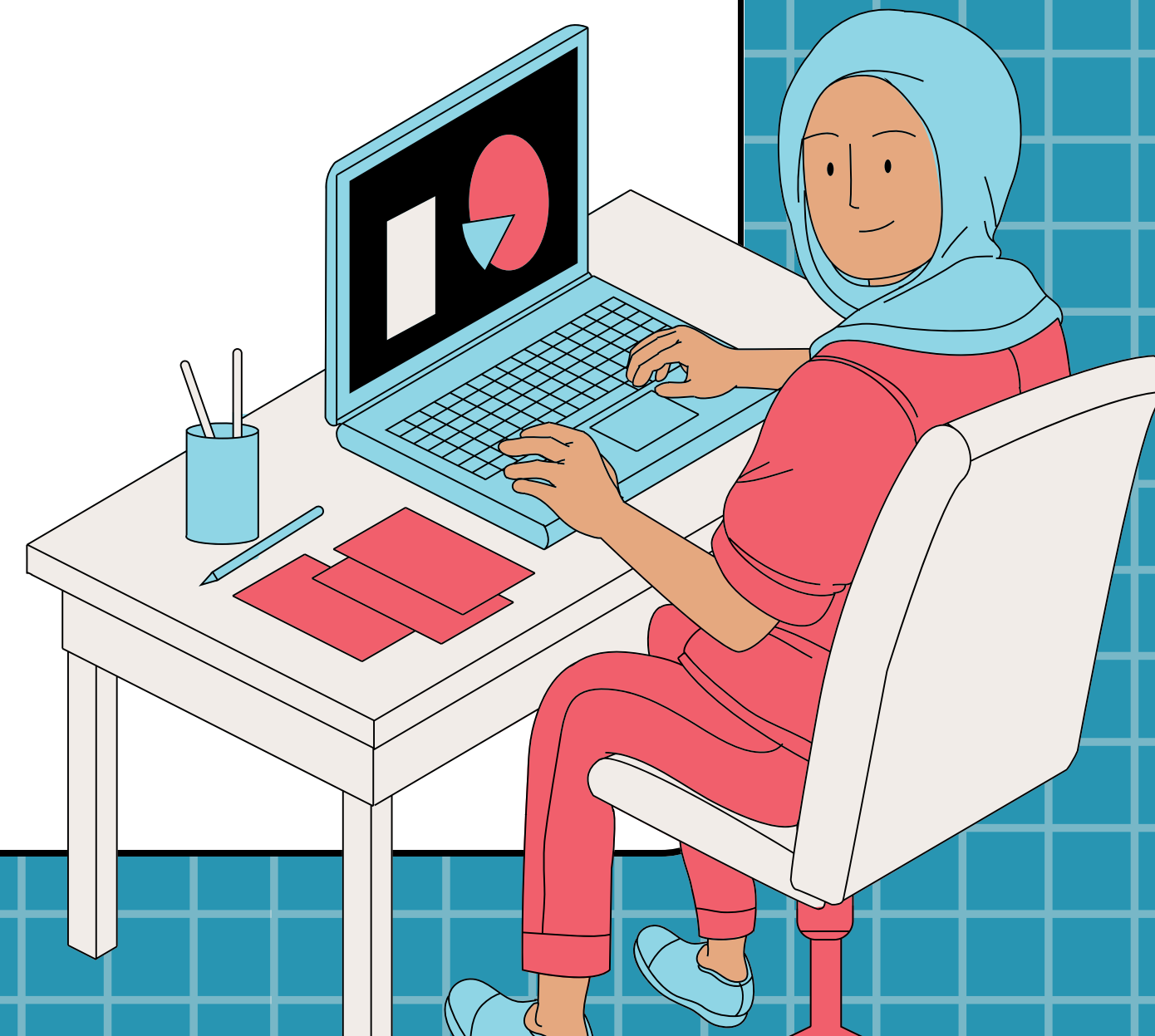

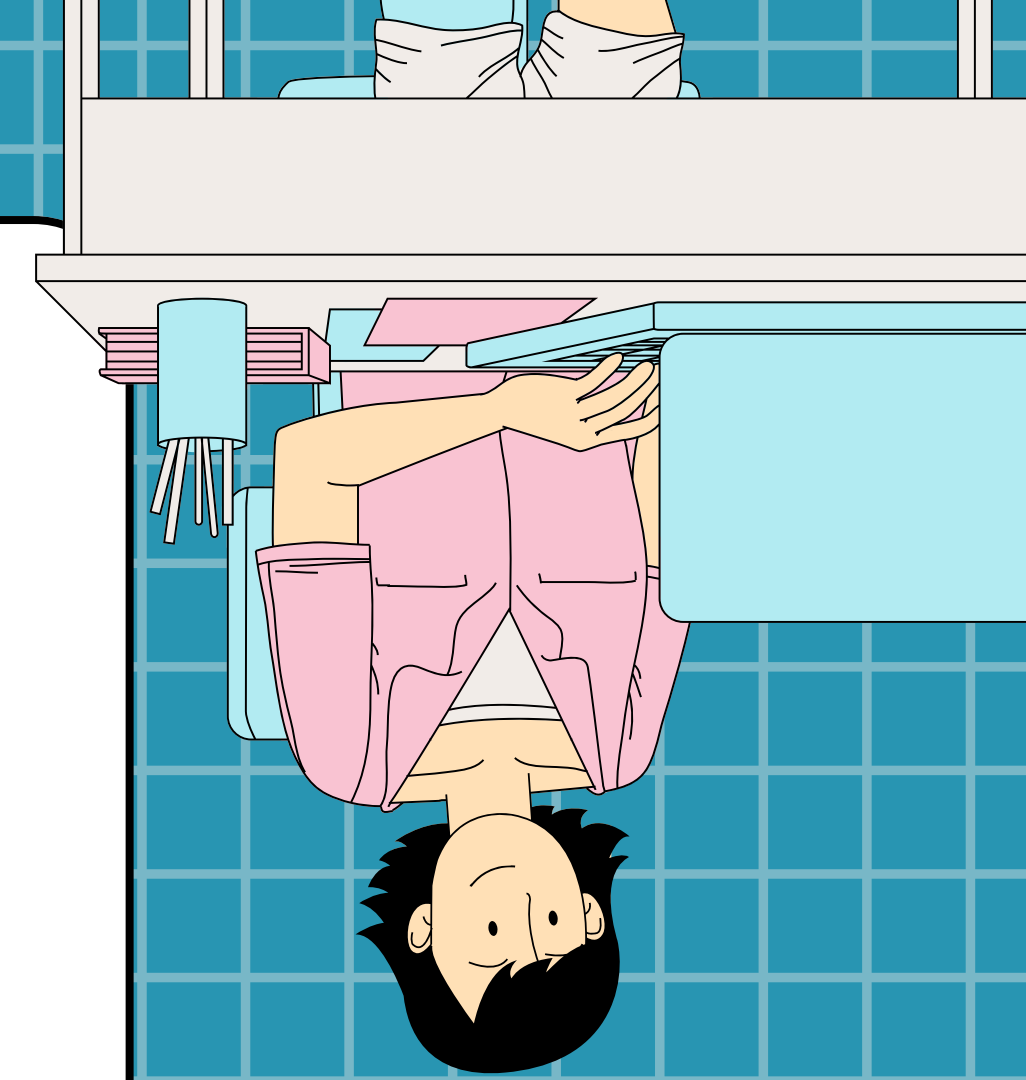
SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH LAYERED

- Demographics

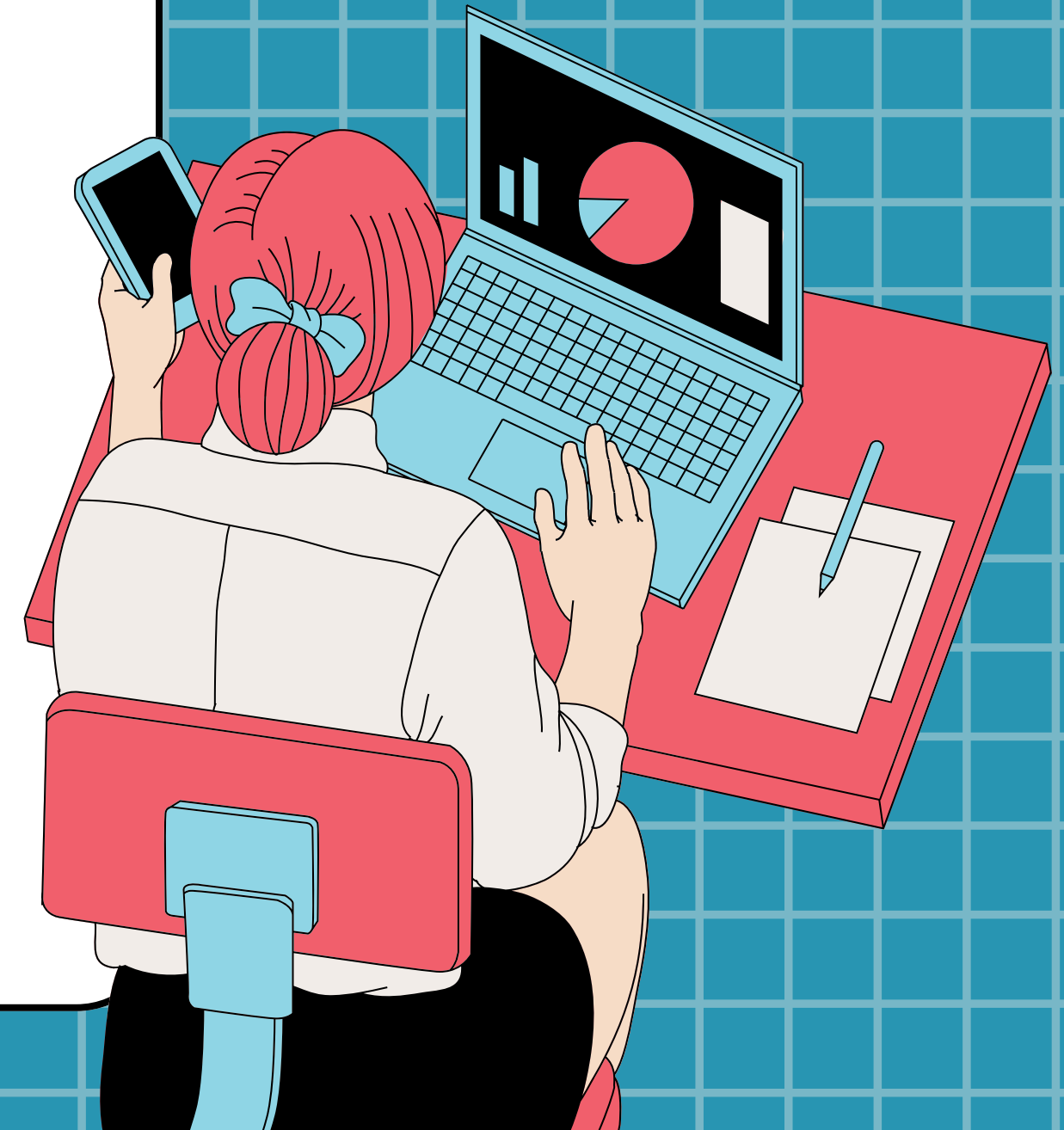
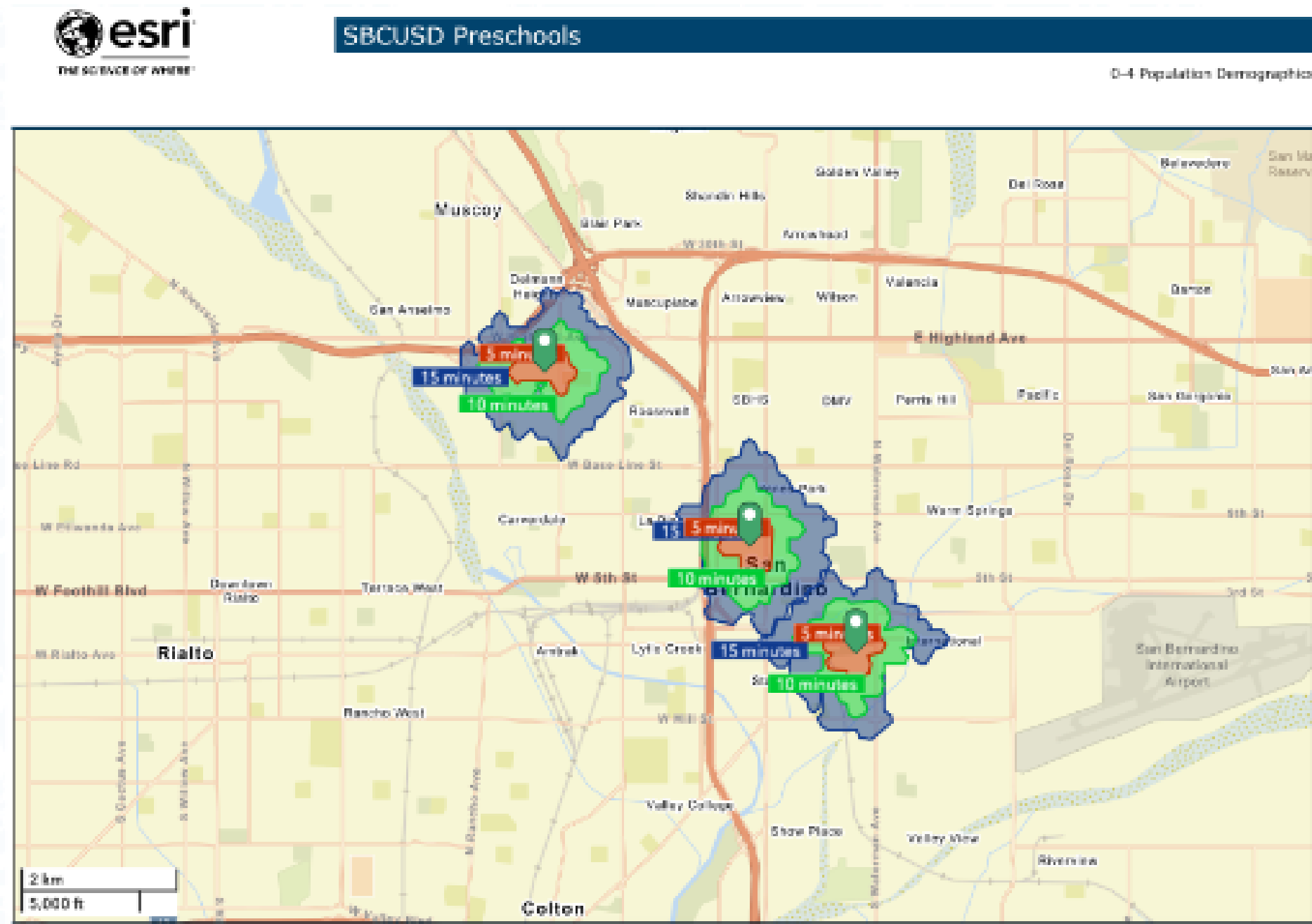


CRIME MAPS

PRE-K RECRUITMENT



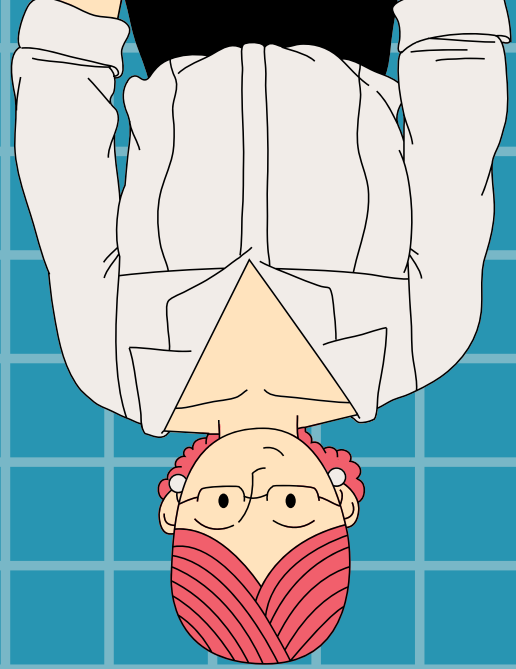
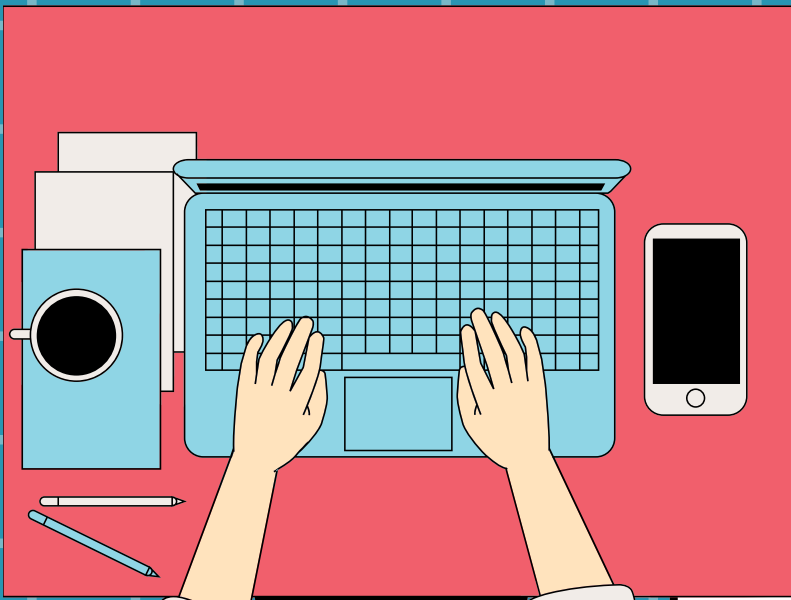
DATA CONTEXT

- Annual evaluation = program modifications
 - Parent Health Institute
 - Intensive home visit curriculum
 - CHEW Text Connect
 - Little libraries
 - Lunch time engagement
 - Diaper and food distribution
